# 3. Strategic Steps to Accomplish Project:

- 1. Change of work schedules to better serve our community while ensuring we provide 24/7 police services.
- In the Spring of 2020, the Patrol Division of the St. Helens Police Department changed staffing work schedules from a 12-hour shift to a 10-hour shift. By implementing this shift schedule change, it provides a 3 hour overlap of officers from the different shifts to be working at the same time. This change allows our officers to conduct more traffic safety patrols in our community.
- As a result of this change, officers are more responsive to the request of our residents when they have a traffic
  complaint in their neighborhoods. Officers will contact the residents to determine the issues/challenges and
  work together on a solution. Prior to this schedule change, we often were not afforded the time for personal
  contact with our resident.
- Officers are now afforded the time to conduct traffic enforcement in areas we have a high volume of vehicle traffic to prevent accidents. The goal of this enforcement is to reduce accidents while increasing driver safety. This enforcement is done through a variety of ways to include mere presence, verbal warnings our issuing citations. Our goal with traffic enforcement is to change driving behaviors.
