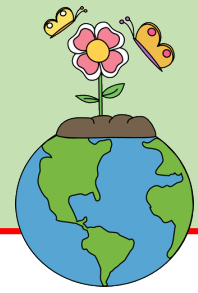

Acceptable Hazardous Waste Materials:

- Thinners and solvents
- Pesticides, herbicides and poisons
- Household cleaners, disinfectants and detergents
- Light ballasts-*remove from light fixture*
- Fluorescent tubes
- Ammunition
- Propane cylinders
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Pool and spa chemicals
- Art and hobby chemicals
- Gasoline/diesel/fuels
- Batteries (*car, rechargeable, button, alkaline*)
- Fireworks / flares
- Items containing mercury



**HAZARDOUS DISPOSAL
IS FREE OF CHARGE**

Items NOT accepted:

- ⊘ Household garbage or trash
- ⊘ Asbestos
- ⊘ Prescriptions/over the counter medications
- ⊘ Liquid in containers larger than 5 gallons

For all other materials and liquids in containers larger than 5 gallons and commercial generators (CEG) **Call Mark Hayes of ACT Enviro** at least 2 weeks prior to event at 971-303-2972 for appt.

Items accepted for free during regular business hours at the Transfer Station:

Accepted Products (maximum container size is 5 gallons, original can & label):

- ✓ Exterior and Interior Paints: latex, acrylic and oil-based
- ✓ Enamel, stains, shellacs, lacquers, varnishes and primers
- ✓ Used motor oil and antifreeze
- ✓ Medical sharps (in a sealed, puncture-proof container-available at the Transfer Station scale house)
- ✓ Electronics-TV's, computers, monitors
