This report covers Planning Commission activities from June 2015 through May 2016.

Number of meetings: 12

Number of public hearings (a continued hearing is counted separately): 20

Acceptance Agenda Items: 14

For administrative land use actions that are more significant (e.g., Site Design Review) the Commission motions to formally accept the decisions or otherwise. This is a check and balance of sorts.

Planning Director Decisions: 53

For lesser administrative land use actions (e.g., Home Occupations, Sign Permits, Temporary Use Permits), the items from the last month are included on the agenda to facilitate discussion and query usually for clarification purposes or to address concerns.

Discussion Items/Workshops: 5

Items included (in no particular order): CLG grant application and scoring; earth removal, trail development, and housekeeping text amendments, year-end summary report (calendar year); chair/vice chair selection; and the annual report to Council.

County Referral: 0

The Commission has the opportunity to comment on certain land use actions outside city limits, but inside the St. Helens Urban Growth Boundary.

Architectural review: 2

Certain proposals within the Riverfront District require architectural review.

Projects in process: The City's third Historic Preservation Rehabilitation Grant (funded by CLG funds) is in process.

Future projects/plans: The Commission is largely reactionary in that it reviews things as they come. Continuing to amend the code is likely. There may also be historic preservation matters that arise too.

What can the Council do to support the Commission?

At their May 10, 2016 meeting, the Commission discussed the following:

- The Commission discussed including language in the code that requires documentation of historic structures (official and unofficial) prior to demolition. For example, pictures to remember the structure. This is something staff can explore the next time we do miscellaneous code amendments or as time allows.
- The Commission is concerned that our land use laws for marijuana related land uses only addresses Marijuana retailers/dispensaries and not other uses such as grow operations (marijuana producers) and processors. The comments about this concern include distances from schools and amount of said uses allowed within the city.

Background -

At the May 4 Regular Session the City Council heard protests from two property owners regarding the assessment for the sewer lateral abatement that was completed for each home. Below is a summary of the previous report and timeline of events that led up to the City taking abatement action.

Summary -

The property was properly notified and posted. The nuisance was discovered six years prior to the repairs and the property owner did not comply during that time despite repeated contact. Property owner alleges that repairs were completed, however no permit was issued and no inspection was performed for work at the address. Photos provided of the alleged repairs do not show proof of location or compliance with building codes. When the abatement repairs were completed, a total of 35 feet of sewer pipe required replacement by City's contractor, therefore the owner's alleged repairs did not address the majority of the sewer lateral issues.

During the abatement process, Owner met with Engineering and Public Works staff to discuss the proposed repair work. Engineering agreed that the City would absorb the cost of the repairs required to be performed on the neighbor's property, including the necessary removal and replacement of a tree over the lateral, and that Owner would only be charged for work completed on his property.

Recommendations –

In accordance with the recommendations of the May 18, 2016 Memorandum from Jon Ellis, Finance Director, to the City Council, there were sufficient considerations and cost adjustment made to the abatement costs that the assessment stands. The process pursued by the property owner did not resolve the primary issue. The City made significant modifications to the costs incurred with the repair of the sewer lateral.

Notice of Sewer Lateral Abatement Posted on September 8, 2015

City of St. Helens Council hereby directs a notice be posted on the <u>lot at 475 South 14th Street, Parcel Map #4N1W 4DD 9400</u>, that the property is in violation of one or more sections of the St. Helens Municipal Code (SHMC) listed below:

SHMC Section 8.12.130:

"No person in charge of any building or structure shall suffer or permit rain water to fall from any such building or structure onto any street or sidewalk or to flow across such sidewalk or cause it to be discharged into any sanitary sewer;" SHMC Section 13.12.040(8). (12), and (13):

"No person shall make connection of roof downspouts, exterior foundation drains, areaway drains, or other sources of surface runoff or ground water to a building sewer or building drain, which in turn is connected directly or indirectly to a public sanitary sewer."

"Service laterals from a structure to the main sewer line shall be maintained by the owner of said structure in such a manner as to prevent infiltration of ground water into the collection system."

"Service laterals constructed or comprised of any prohibited material, specifically bituminous fiber pipe, most commonly known as "Orangeburg pipe," may constitute a threat to the efficient working and operation of the sanitary collection system and/or of the wastewater treatment plant and facilities of the city and may constitute a hazard to the health of the citizens of the city. In order to reduce or eliminate the risk, threats, and hazards posed by the existence of such unapproved pipe, prohibition is necessary. Building sewers constructed or compromised of unapproved materials, including "Orangeburg" or bituminous fiber pipe shall be deemed in need of repair or replacement when: (a) The service lateral is in failure as determined by the city engineer. A sewer lateral constructed of bituminous fiber pipe is considered to be in failure when certain conditions are present. Some of these conditions include, but are not limited to: collapsed pipe, blistering or peeling pipe, structural failure of the pipe, sags and bulges in line greater than 25 percent of pipe diameter, root intrusion, separated or leaking joints, visibly cracked or broken pipe, or pipe material deterioration. (b) Any additions, repairs, alterations, renovations, replacements, or maintenance are made to the service lateral. In all cases, the entire length of unapproved pipe material shall be removed and replaced and the costs and expenses incident to the repair and/or replacement of the unapproved pipe shall be borne by the owner. Replacement or repaired pipe shall conform to current applicable regulations and the requirements of this code for building sewers.

SHMC Section 13.12.050(1) and (2):

"No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any storm water, surface water, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, uncontaminated cooling water, or unpolluted industrial process waters to any sanitary sewer."

"No person shall make connection of roof downspouts, exterior foundation drains, areaway drains, or other sources of surface runoff or ground water to a public sanitary sewer."

The property owner or person in charge of the property described in this Notice is directed to make repairs on the deficient sanitary sewer lateral within thirty (30) days of this notice (on or before October 8, 2015). Obtaining a plumbing permit from the St. Helens Building Department for the purpose of making the required repairs will be considered taking action to complete the repairs.

If the property owner or the person in charge of the property fails to remove the nuisance by making the repairs and/or obtaining a valid plumbing permit for the purpose of performing the repairs, the City of St. Helens will remove the nuisance by means of having the repairs completed and the cost of the repairs shall be assessed against the property. Failure to pay the assessment shall result in the City placing a lien against the property, including any and all additional costs associated with filing the lien. You may protest this action by giving notice in writing to the city recorder within ten (10) days from the date of this notice (on or before September 18, 2015). For the past several years St. Helens has been working to comply with State and Federal regulations concerning raw sewage overflows during heavy rain events caused by stormwater and groundwater entering the sanitary sewer system through leaks, cracks, breaks, direct stormwater connections, and deteriorated sewer pipe. Great improvements have been made in the operational functionality of our wastewater and stormwater system thanks to the combined effort of the City and numerous St. Helens property owners.

There are, however, a few sewer laterals that remain out of compliance. On September 2, 2015, City Council passed a resolution declaring these unrepaired sewer laterals a public nuisance. The properties with nuisance sewers were placed on the Deficient Sewer Lateral Abatement list and the violations were posted on the premises. Starting this week, the City will begin to perform nuisance sewer lateral abatement repairs. The services of Inland Company Inc. has been secured to do this work.

You are receiving this Construction Notification because you either own one of the properties on which a nuisance sewer lateral exists or because you own property adjacent to one of the nuisance sewer lateral properties and it is determined that your neighbor's sewer lateral may extend onto your property. The City's contractor may have to access your property for the purposes of repairing or replacing the nuisance sewer and will contact you directly.

Contractor working hours will be generally limited to the hours of 8:00am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday. Everything will be done to minimize disturbance to your property and any damaged property or landscaping will be restored to an equal or better condition. (b) Any additions, repairs, alterations, renovations, replacements, or maintenance are made to the service lateral. In all cases, the entire length of unapproved pipe material shall be removed and replaced and the costs and expenses incident to the repair and/or replacement of the unapproved pipe shall be borne by the owner. Replacement or repaired pipe shall conform to current applicable regulations and the requirements of this code for building sewers.

SHMC Section 13.12.050(1) and (2):

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The property owner or person in charge of the property described in this Notice is directed to make repairs on the deficient sanitary sewer lateral within thirty (30) days of this notice (on or before October 8, 2015). Obtaining a plumbing permit from the St. Helens Building Department for the purpose of making the required repairs will be considered taking action to complete the repairs.

If the property owner or the person in charge of the property fails to remove the nuisance by making the repairs and/or obtaining a valid plumbing permit for the purpose of performing the repairs, the City of St. Helens will remove the nuisance by means of having the repairs completed and the cost of the repairs shall be assessed against the property. Failure to pay the assessment shall result in the City placing a lien against the property, including any and all additional costs associated with filing the lien. You may protest this action by giving notice in writing to the city recorder within ten (10) days from the date of this notice (on or before September 18, 2015). For the past several years St. Helens has been working to comply with State and Federal regulations concerning raw sewage overflows during heavy rain events caused by stormwater and groundwater entering the sanitary sewer system through leaks, cracks, breaks, direct stormwater connections, and deteriorated sewer pipe. Great improvements have been made in the operational functionality of our wastewater and stormwater system thanks to the combined effort of the City and numerous St. Helens property owners.

There are, however, a few sewer laterals that remain out of compliance. On September 2, 2015, City Council passed a resolution declaring these unrepaired sewer laterals a public nuisance. The properties with nuisance sewers were placed on the Deficient Sewer Lateral Abatement list and the violations were posted on the premises. Starting this week, the City will begin to perform nuisance sewer lateral abatement repairs. The services of Inland Company Inc. has been secured to do this work.

You are receiving this Construction Notification because you either own one of the properties on which a nuisance sewer lateral exists or because you own property adjacent to one of the nuisance sewer lateral properties and it is determined that your neighbor's sewer lateral may extend onto your property. The City's contractor may have to access your property for the purposes of repairing or replacing the nuisance sewer and will contact you directly.

Contractor working hours will be generally limited to the hours of 8:00am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday. Everything will be done to minimize disturbance to your property and any damaged property or landscaping will be restored to an equal or better condition. Please observe and respect all temporary construction barriers, equipment, materials, and working personnel.

This time has been set-a-side to hear protests to Sewer Lateral Abatements on the following properties:

• 475 S 14th Street

135 N 4th Street

Staff has attached a timeline with applicable documentation for each property for City Council's review and further consideration. Staff will be available at the Council meeting to provide further background and to answer any questions.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that City Council find the following:

• On the Sewer Lateral Abatement at 475 S 14th Street – that there was sufficient notification and reasonable expectations that the assessment stands.

The bottom line – it is the property owner's responsibility for outstanding assessments. If they believe that they were not properly informed by the seller, they may have their own avenue of recourse.

• On the Sewer Lateral Abatement at 135 N 4th Street – that there was sufficient considerations and cost adjustments that the assessment stands.

The bottom line – the processed pursued by the property was not incompliance with existing City codes. Further the work alleged completed by the property owner did not resolve the main issue. The City made significant modifications to the costs incurred with the repair of the sewer lateral.

Protest of Sewer Lateral Abatement At 475 South 14th Street, St. Helens

The following is the timeline of the noticing and abatement of sewer lateral for subject property:

- 1. <u>September 8, 2015</u> Property Posted and notice sent to property owner per property tax recorders was Mr. Wayne Naperry (index 1-1 through 1-2).
- 2. <u>January 19, 2016</u> Fannie MAE rep contacted City on Notice. They were informed that work was in the cue and a subsequent lien pending (index 2).
- 3. <u>February 2, 2016</u> Sewer Lateral Capped (please note that September Noticed was still posted and visible) (Index 3-1 through 3-5).
- 4. February 18, 2016 Property posted as unfit for occupancy (index 4-1 through 4-3)
- 5. <u>February 26, 2016</u> Property recorded new Property owner Alicia Turner. Please note a slew of changes posted with different dates/times (index 5-1 through 5-4).
- 6. March 2, 2016 Plumbing permit pulled by Alicia Turner and sewer lateral repaired and connected to sewer main (index 6)
- 7. April 15, 2016 City correspondence billing for services mailed (index 7-1 through 7-2).
- 8. <u>April 19, 2016</u> memorandum from City of St Helens Engineering Project Manager, Sharon Darroux received outlining experience on subject property (index 8).
- 9. April 29, 2016 letter of protest from new property owner Alicia Turner (index 9)

City of St. Helens RESOLUTION NO. 1711

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT A NUISANCE EXISTS UPON PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF ST. HELENS AND DIRECTING THAT NOTICE TO ABATE THE NUISANCE BE POSTED ON SAID PREMISES

WHEREAS, St. Helens Municipal Code (SHMC) Section 8.12.010(1)(d), 8.12.130, 13.12.040(8), 13.12.040(12), 13.12.040(13), 13.12.050(1), 13.12.050(2), and 13.12.090(1) makes connection of downspouts, roof runoff, foundations drains, areaway drains, storm water, surface water, subsurface drainage, groundwater infiltration, bituminous fiber pipe, or other sources or surface runoff or ground water to a public sewer a violation of city code and a nuisance; and

WHEREAS, video inspections have revealed the existence of one or more of the prohibited defects in the building sewer laterals for the parcels listed in Exhibit A, attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the parcels listed in Exhibit A are nuisance parcels and the City has the ability to abate the nuisance pursuant to SHMC 8.12.220 - 8.12.260.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ST. HELENS RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The parcels listed in Exhibit A to this Resolution constitute nuisance parcels.

Section 2. Council hereby directs a notice to be posted on each premise listed in Exhibit A which contains: a description of the real property, by street address or otherwise; a direction to remove (repair) the nuisance within 30 days of the date of the notice; a description of the nuisance; a statement that unless such nuisance is removed (repaired), the City will remove (repair) the nuisance and the cost of removal (repair) shall be a lien against the property; and a statement that the person in charge of the property may protest the action by giving notice to the City Recorder within ten (10) days from the date of the notice.

Section 3. The City Recorder shall cause a copy of said notice to be forwarded by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, to the person in charge of the property at the last known address of such person. If the person responsible for the nuisance is not the owner, an additional notice shall be sent to the owner, stating that the cost of abatement not paid by the person responsible may be assessed to and become a lien on the property.





Hi Jon,

Here's what I have concerning Todd Eidem's protest of the nuisance sewer lateral repair charges of \$2,587.20 for 135 N 4th St,

- The amount of the work that Mr. Eidem is being billed for is less than the actual cost of work done, which the City may at its discretion choose to charge.
 - The total cost of work done due to the property owner's noncompliance with St. Helens Municipal Code 13.12 is well over \$3,570.00, not including administrative fees.
 - At our discretion, the cost of work done to remove a tree, and locate and uncover the portion of Mr. Eidem's lateral which runs along the west property line of his neighbor's property at 145 N 4th St has not been charged to him. He was also not charged time and materials for the several Public Works employees who assisted in this work, nor was he charged for the Contractor's time spent the morning of February 4, 2016 when they were prevented from entering onto the property for approximately two hours. These extra costs, not shown on the invoice, is an additional \$672.00, bringing his actual total cost to \$4,242.00
- The greater portion of the sewer lateral for 145 N 4th St in on the property of 135 N 4th St. Per St.
 Helens Municipal Code, the property owner owns their sewer lateral from their home to the sewer
 main, even if their lateral extends beyond their property line and into neighboring property or public
 right-of-way. This means that all sewer lateral work done on Mr. Eidem's sewer on his neighbor's
 property is the responsibility of Mr. Eidem, including and not limited to construction, installation,
 maintenance, and repair of the sewer lateral.
- Once we gained access to the property to abate the nuisance, it was found the some repairs had been
 done on the sewer without the necessary plumbing permit. This work has not been verified and we
 were shown some undated photographs of a sewer under repair. Our Contractor still did find portions
 of the sewer needing to be replaced, including the open connection of an abandoned storm pipe which
 we capped off.

WHEREAS, St. Helens Municipal Code (SHMC) Section 8.12.010(1)(d), 8.12.130, 13.12.040(8), 13.12.040(12), 13.12.040(13), 13.12.050(1), 13.12.050(2), and 13.12.090(1) makes connection of downspouts, roof runoff, foundations drains, areaway drains, storm water, surface water, subsurface drainage, groundwater infiltration, bituminous fiber pipe, or other sources or surface runoff or ground water to a public sewer a violation of city code and a nuisance; and

WHEREAS, video inspections have revealed the existence of one or more of the prohibited defects in the building sewer laterals for the parcels listed in Exhibit A, attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the parcels listed in Exhibit A are nuisance parcels and the City has the ability to abate the nuisance pursuant to SHMC 8.12.220 - 8.12.260.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ST. HELENS RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The parcels listed in Exhibit A to this Resolution constitute nuisance parcels.

Section 2. Council hereby directs a notice to be posted on each premise listed in Exhibit A which contains: a description of the real property, by street address or otherwise; a direction to remove (repair) the nuisance within 30 days of the date of the notice; a description of the nuisance; a statement that unless such nuisance is removed (repaired), the City will remove (repair) the nuisance and the cost of removal (repair) shall be a lien against the property; and a statement that the person in charge of the property may protest the action by giving notice to the City Recorder within ten (10) days from the date of the notice.

Section 3. The City Recorder shall cause a copy of said notice to be forwarded by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, to the person in charge of the property at the last known address of such person. If the person responsible for the nuisance is not the owner, an additional notice shall be sent to the owner, stating that the cost of abatement not paid by the person responsible may be assessed to and become a lien on the property.

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT ADDITIONAL NUISANCES EXIST UPON PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN ST. HELENS AND DIRECTING THAT NOTICE TO ABATE THE ADDITIONAL NUISANCES BE POSTED ON SAID PREMISES

WHEREAS, St. Helens Municipal Code (SHMC) Section 8.12.250 provides that "[u]pon determination by the common council that a nuisance as defined in this chapter or any other ordinance of the city exists, or can reasonably be expected to come into existence within the next 30 days, the common council shall forthwith cause a notice to be posted on the premises liable for the abatement, directing the removal of such nuisance." SHMC Section 8.14.040(4) provides that "[a] structure is unfit for human occupancy whenever the building official finds that such structure is unsafe, unlawful or, because of the degree to which the structure is in disrepair or lacks maintenance, is insanitary, vermin or rat infested, contains filth and contamination, or lacks ventilation, illumination, sanitary or heating facilities or other essential equipment required by this chapter." Finally, SHMC 8.14.040(1) provides that "[w]hen a structure or equipment is found by an enforcement official to be unsafe, unfit for human occupancy, or otherwise unlawful, such structure or equipment is in violation of this chapter and a nuisance which shall be abated . . . "; and

WHEREAS, the structures identified in Exhibit A have been previously determined by the City Council to be nuisance properties because they were in violation of SHMC Chapter 13.12, Sewer Use Regulations; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the City's efforts to comply with the Oregon State Department of Environmental Quality's Inflow and Infiltration rules, City has been upgrading the sewer lines and identifying sewer laterals which are broken, leaking or otherwise in violation of the sewer use regulations and requiring those defective laterals to be repaired or replaced prior to connecting to the new sewer lines; and

WHEREAS, the structures in Exhibit A have defective laterals which have not been repaired or replaced and therefore, will not be allowed to connect to the new sewer lines and will therefore be cut and capped during the month of February, 2016, making the structures in Exhibit A unfit for human occupancy in addition to the other violations of St. Helens Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to abate these additional nuisances pursuant to SHMC 8.12.250.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ST. HELENS RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Council hereby finds that each of the structures listed in Exhibit A can reasonably be expected to become unfit for human occupancy and therefore a nuisance within the next 30 days and directs a notice to be posted on structures identified in Exhibit A which contains: a description of the real property, by street address or otherwise; a direction to remove the nuisance within 30 days of the date of the notice; a description of the nuisance; a statement that, unless a permanent abatement of the nuisance is performed within 30 days of the notice, the City will permanently remove the nuisance and that the costs shall be a lien against the property; and a statement that the person in charge of the property may protest the action by giving notice to the City Recorder within ten (10) days from the date of the notice.

Section 2. The City Recorder shall cause a copy of said notice to be forwarded by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, to the person in charge of each of the structures at the last known address of such person. That notice shall contain all the elements listed in paragraph 2., supra, that is, the posting. If the person responsible for the nuisance is not the owner, an additional notice shall be sent to the owner, stating that the cost of abatement not paid by the person responsible may be assessed to and become a lien on the property.

Concerning the nuisance sewer lateral at 475 S 14th St, I believe I spoke with Alicia Turner by phone on at least one occasion concerning the sewer lateral at this property. In addition to this, I have on record, a summary of the telephone conversation I had with the property's realtor, a Fannie Mae representative, on the sewer lateral issues.

To my knowledge, it seems impossible the current property would have been unaware of the nuisances associated with this property for these reasons,

- A Notice of Sewer Lateral Abatement was posted on the property on September 8, 2015.
- I spoke with the Fannie Mae realtor about this property on January 19, 2016. (Please see attached)
- I believe I spoke with Alicia Turner in late January/early February concerning the sewer lateral issues at this property.
- The sewer lateral was capped on February 2, 2016. The Notice of Sewer Lateral Abatement was still posted on the property at this time.
- The house was posted again uninhabitable per Resolution 1732, dated February 17, 2016

It was found that there were holes in the sewer line by the inspector that I hired. After that, my realtor told me that he called the city and they told him that they would be capping off the sewer line. No one in this entire process of buying this property did anyone tell me that I could be held financially responsible for this. I paid to have the sewer line replaced and to have the exterior of the house painted. If I would have been informed that I could be held responsible for the capping off of the sewer line, I most likely would not have bought the property because, I wouldn't be able to afford that as well.

We have enjoyed working with you and the community planning the waterfront in St Helens. Its redevelopment will be catalytic to the revitalization of downtown and further connect community to the Columbia River.

Based on our recent conversations, we have developed the following proposal to assist the City in the redevelopment of the gazebo at Columbia View Park. The upgrade of the area will provide an improved venue for events and gatherings along the water.

This report does not indicate all *current planning* activities over the past report period. These are tasks, processing and administration of the Development Code which are a weekly if not daily responsibility. The Planning Commission agenda, available on the City's website, is a good indicator of *current planning* activities. The number of building permits issued is another good indicator as many require Development Code review prior to Building Official review.

PLANNING ADMINISTRATION

As part of USAD partial funded renovations of the Woodland Trails Apartments (345 N. 16th Street) and Norcrest Apartments (184 Bradley Street), the owner wants to remove some trees. I walked the sites with the project superintendent to evaluate the trees to be removed. Some will be replaced based on assumptions of past land use decisions (the projects pre-date good land use records) and proximity to wetlands (Woodland Trails only).

Conducted a pre-application meeting with Lower Columbia Engineering in regards to multiple projects at or around the St. Helens Marina area.

Had a preliminary Q&A meeting regarding potential development of the vacant property south of Columbia Commons (500 N. Columbia River).

DEVELOPMENT CODE ENFORCEMENT

In regards to the latest issue with the disc golf course in McCormick Park as described in last month's department activity report, the city executed an agreement with Oregon DSL and has completed the work and final report per that agreement.

PLANNING COMMISSION (& acting HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION)

<u>May 10, 2016 meeting (outcome)</u>: Three public hearings were scheduled. The Commission conditionally approved a Conditional Use Permit for an RV park by the St. Helens Marina. A second Conditional Use Permit for an RV park by the St. Helens Marina was continued to the June meeting due to design concerns of staff. A Conditional Use Permit for a marijuana production facility in the Houlton area was continued to the June meeting due to unresolved access issues.

The Commission discussed its annual report to Council.

<u>June 14, 2016 meeting (upcoming)</u>: The Commission has two public hearings continued from May. There will be two additional new public hearings. One is for an expansion of the Nazarene Church along Gable Road across from S.H. High School. The other is for a Conditional Use Permit and a couple Variances for a fourplex by the St. Helens Marina.

Routine data updates. Showed Assistant Planner method for updating taxlot data.

Created draft urban review district for consultants to help evaluate urban renewal for the city.
